

The Role

As part of the Coffs Harbour team, your role will include the inspection, assembly, installation, and testing of lifting, rigging, and height safety equipment.

The work will begin as a Monday to Friday gig, but overnight travel (including weekends if required) will be required once you are qualified and assessed as competent. Of course this will come with appropriate allowances and generous penalty rates.

A snapshot of the role includes:

- Assembly, inspection, testing, service, and installation of hoisting and rigging systems and height safety equipment.
- General workshop duties, including maintaining a clean workshop.
- Maintaining records in testing and ERP software.

What we are looking for

As training will be provided, if you are enthusiastic about a new career, have excellent work ethic, and can demonstrate relevant skills and experience, we encourage you to apply, even if you aren't an experienced service technician. We are looking for the following:

- Experience working in an industrial setting, (such as construction, manufacturing, resources, or renewables).

- Willing to undergo a pre-employment medical, including drug and alcohol screening, and additional post-employment assessment and testing (which may be required by clients to access their sites).
- Willing to do overnight travel when required, (once suitably qualified and trained).
- The legal right to work in Australia on a full time, permanent basis.

Ideally you will also have

- Experience working with, manufacturing, inspecting, or testing rigging and lifting systems, height safety equipment or cranes.
- High-Risk Work Licences, including Forklift, Dogging and Basic Rigging, and Elevated Work Platform.
- A current first aid certificate.
