- You have, or can obtain a National Police Clearance that won't prevent you from accessing client sites (e.g. mining, construction, marine transport industries).
- You are willing to travel to client sites, including remote sites when required.
- You have the legal right to work in Australia on a full time, permanent basis.
- Experience with manufacturing, inspection, and testing of rigging systems, would be advantageous.

- A current first aid certificate.
- High-Risk Work Licences, including Forklift, Dogman, Basic Rigging, Elevated Work Platform.
- A Working Safely at Heights qualification.
